INTERSTATE DBE APPLICATION PROCESS

The firm must first be certified by the Unified Certification Program (UCP) in its home state.

Gather the following required documents:

- Complete copy of the firm's home state application along with all supporting documentation
- All annual No-change Affidavits (NCAs) or notices of change filed with the home state
- All correspondence concerning the firm's DBE application and status with the home state or other state UCPs, including certification appeals and responses from USDOT
- Notarized South Dakota Interstate Certification Affidavit

Submit completed application to:

Department of Transportation DBE Program 700 E. Broadway Ave. Pierre SD 57501

The Process

- Staff reviews submitted application and acquires the most recent site visit from the home state's responsible office.
- Staff conducts a financial review.
- Staff notifies the firm and schedules an orientation.
