



Crash History


6 Reported Crashes


- 2 Animal/Vehicle

- 2 Overturn Off-Road
- **O** Fatalities
- 1 Injury
- **5 Property Damage**
- 5 Year Period from 2018 to 2022

- Reported Crash Rate = 4.29
- Statewide Weighted
 Crash Rate = 2.51
 (crashes per million
 vehicle miles of travel)








Proposed Typical Section

- Plants: Western Prairie Fringed Orchid




Environmental, Social and Economic Concerns
