

Grading and Bridge Construction in 1957

> **Bridge Maintenance Performed in 1994 and 2010**



TRAFFIC

2023 Average daily traffic (ADT): 707

2048 Projected ADT: 1227

23.5% Average truck traffic



CRASH HISTORY

5 Reported crashes

(Five-year period from 2019-2023)

- Four (4) animal hit
- All Five (5) were Property Damage Only

Rural principal arterial

- Reported crash rate = 1.43
- Statewide weighted crash rate = 1.56 (crashes per million vehicle miles of travel)



ACCESS MANAGEMENT

Provide safe, efficient access to streets and highways by limiting the number of direct accesses to major roadways.





RIGHT OF WAY (ROW)


Existing width = 100 feet

Purchase additional ROW for 150 feet centered on new alignment

Temporary easements as needed

ENVIRONMENTAL, SOCIAL, AND ECONOMIC CONCERNS

A cultural resources survey will be completed.

The project is being reviewed to determine extent of wetland impacts.

Endangered and threatened species:

- Birds: Whooping Crane, Red Knot
- Mammals: Northern Long-Eared Bat
- Fish: Topeka Shiner
- Plants: Western Prairie Fringed Orchid

CONSTRUCTION TRAFFIC CONTROL


Road will be open to traffic during construction

Existing bridge will stay in service while new bridge and grade are constructed



CONSTRUCTION TRAFFIC CONTROL

New bridge to be offset 60 ft to North of existing bridge

Landowners adjacent to the project will be contacted individually by SDDOT to schedule a meeting.


