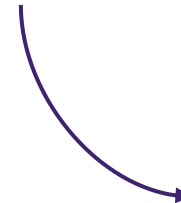

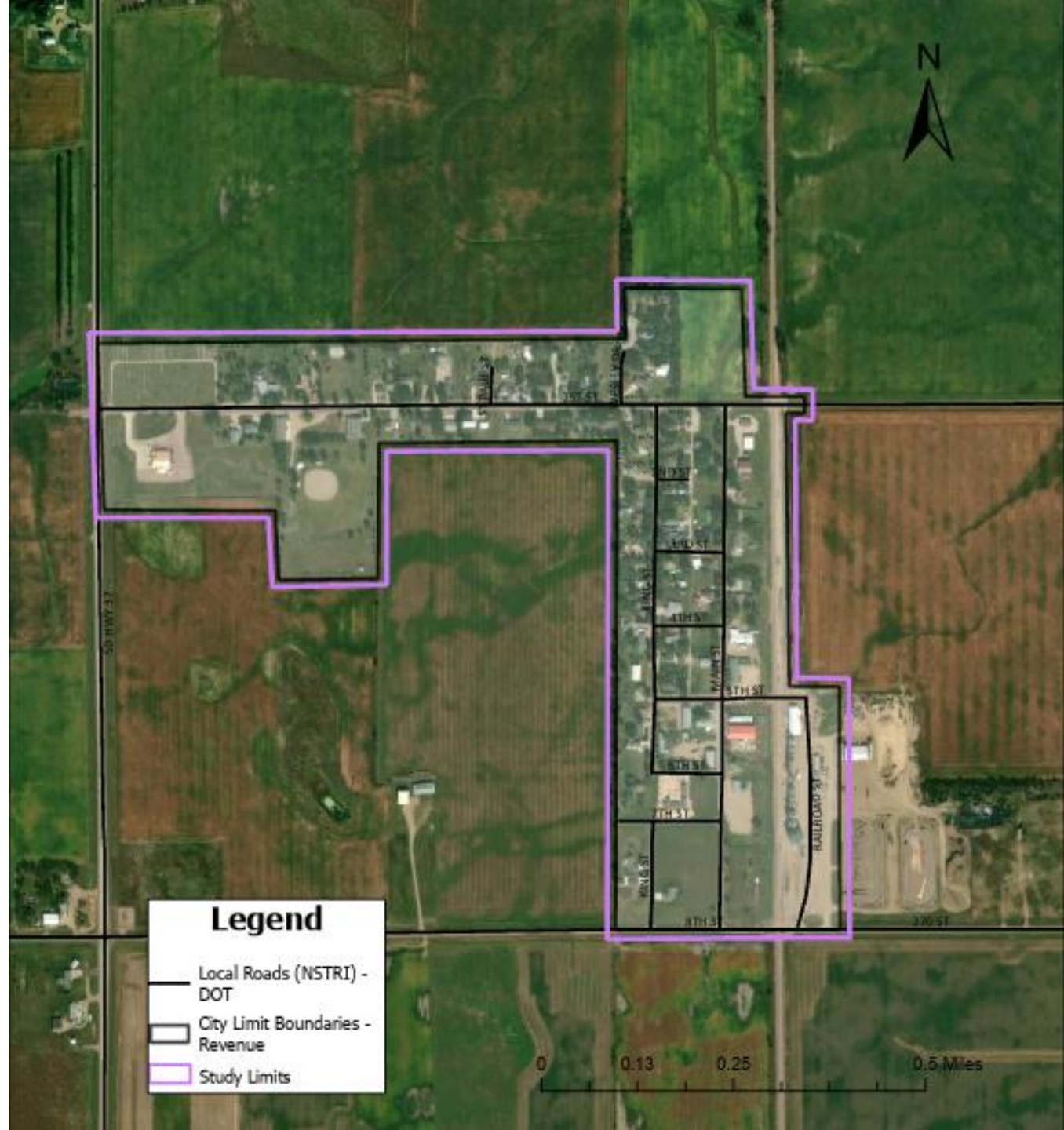


# Inventory of Existing Conditions



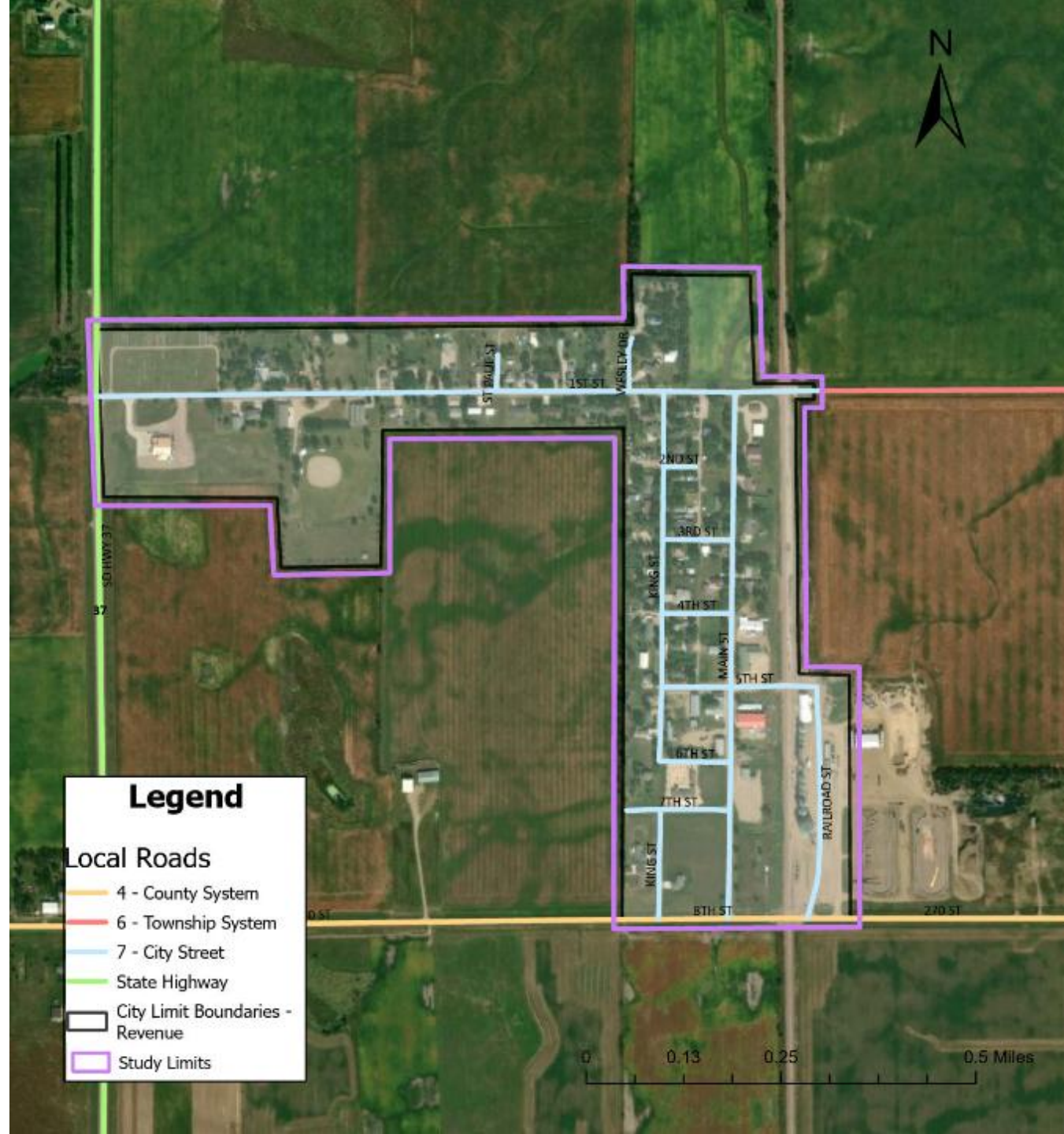


# Study Area Map

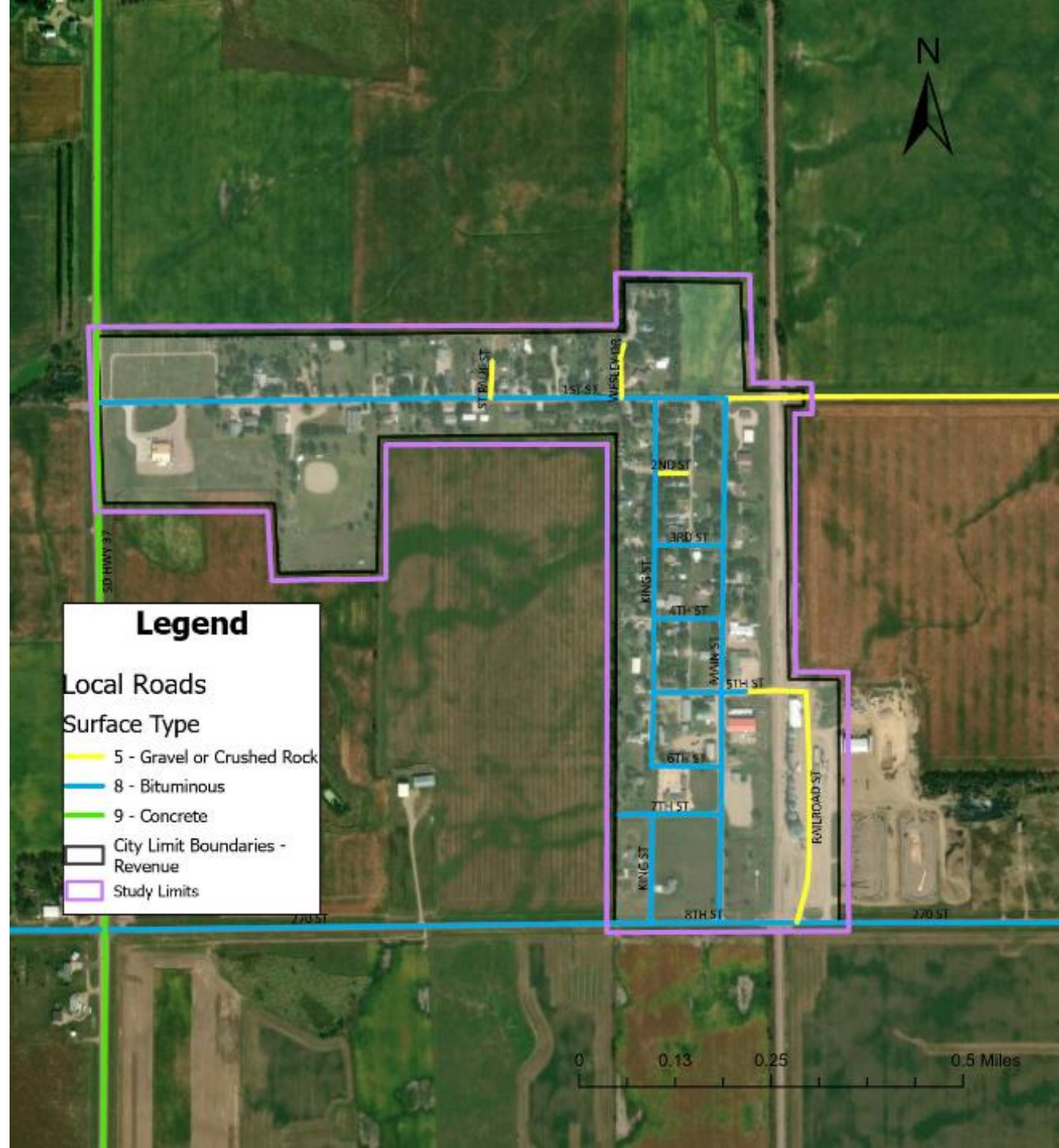




# Road Jurisdiction Map

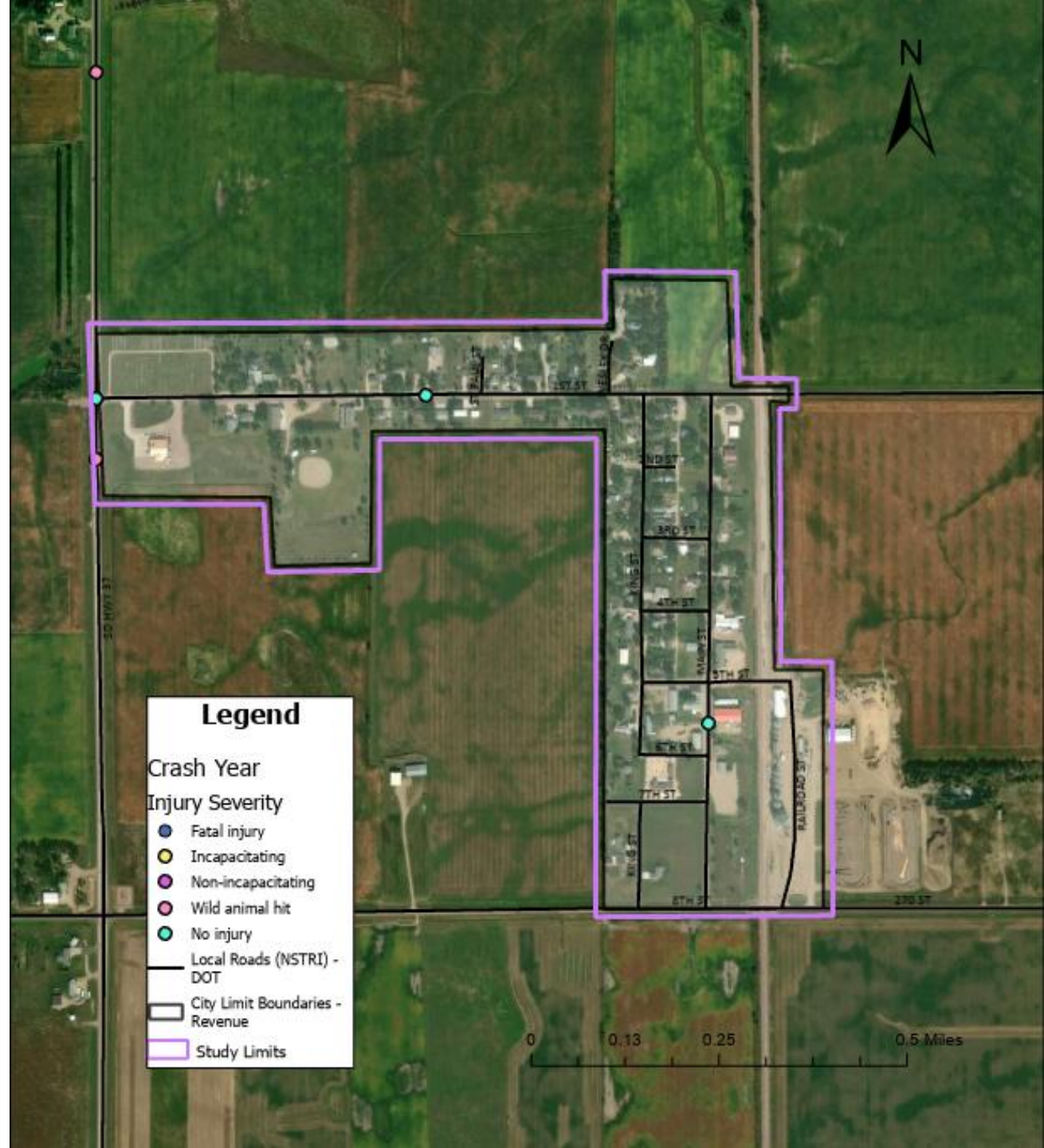


# Road Surface Type Map

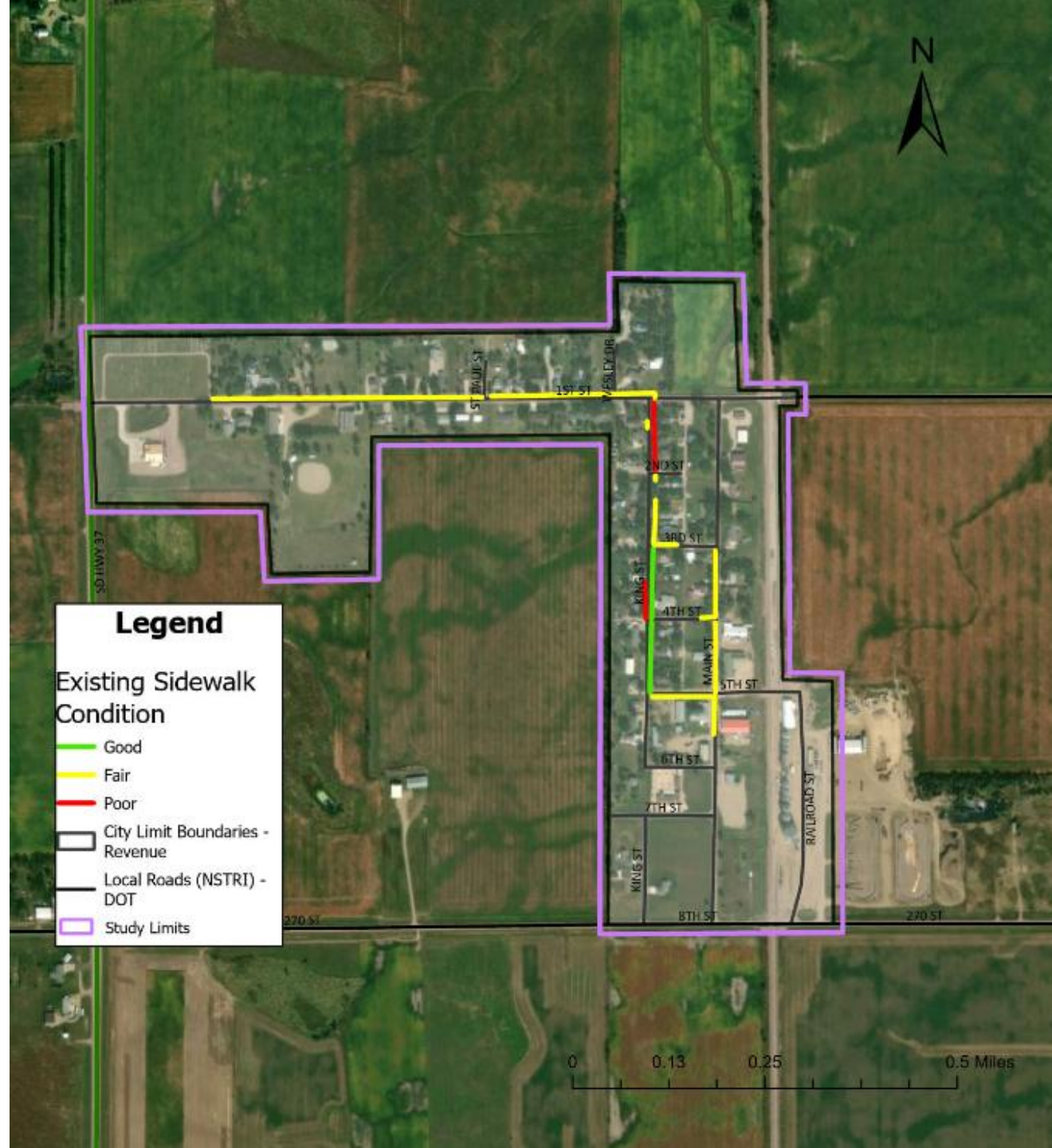




# Crash Location and Severity Map(2022-2026)

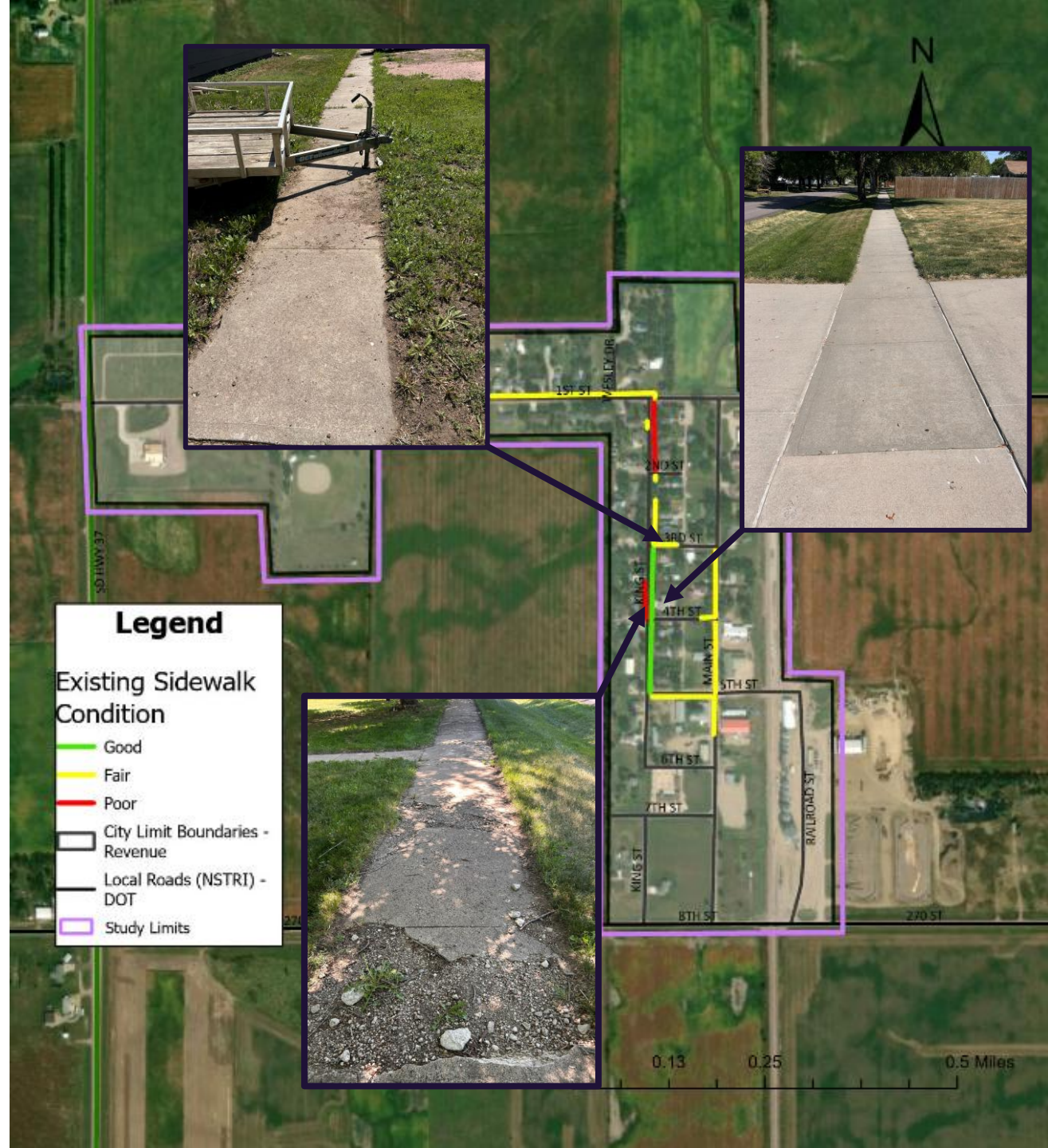


# Sidewalk Condition Map



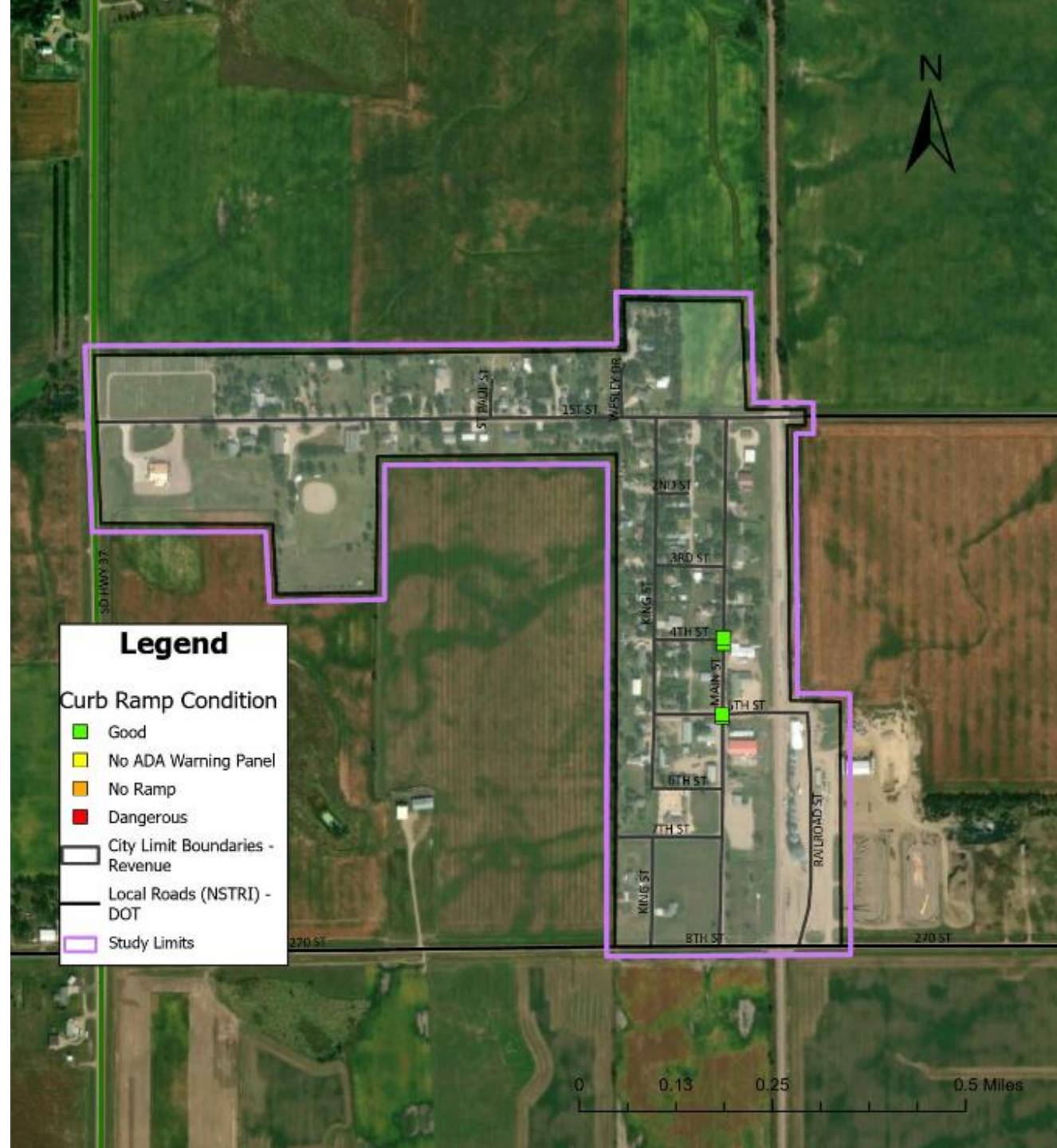


# Sidewalk Condition Map



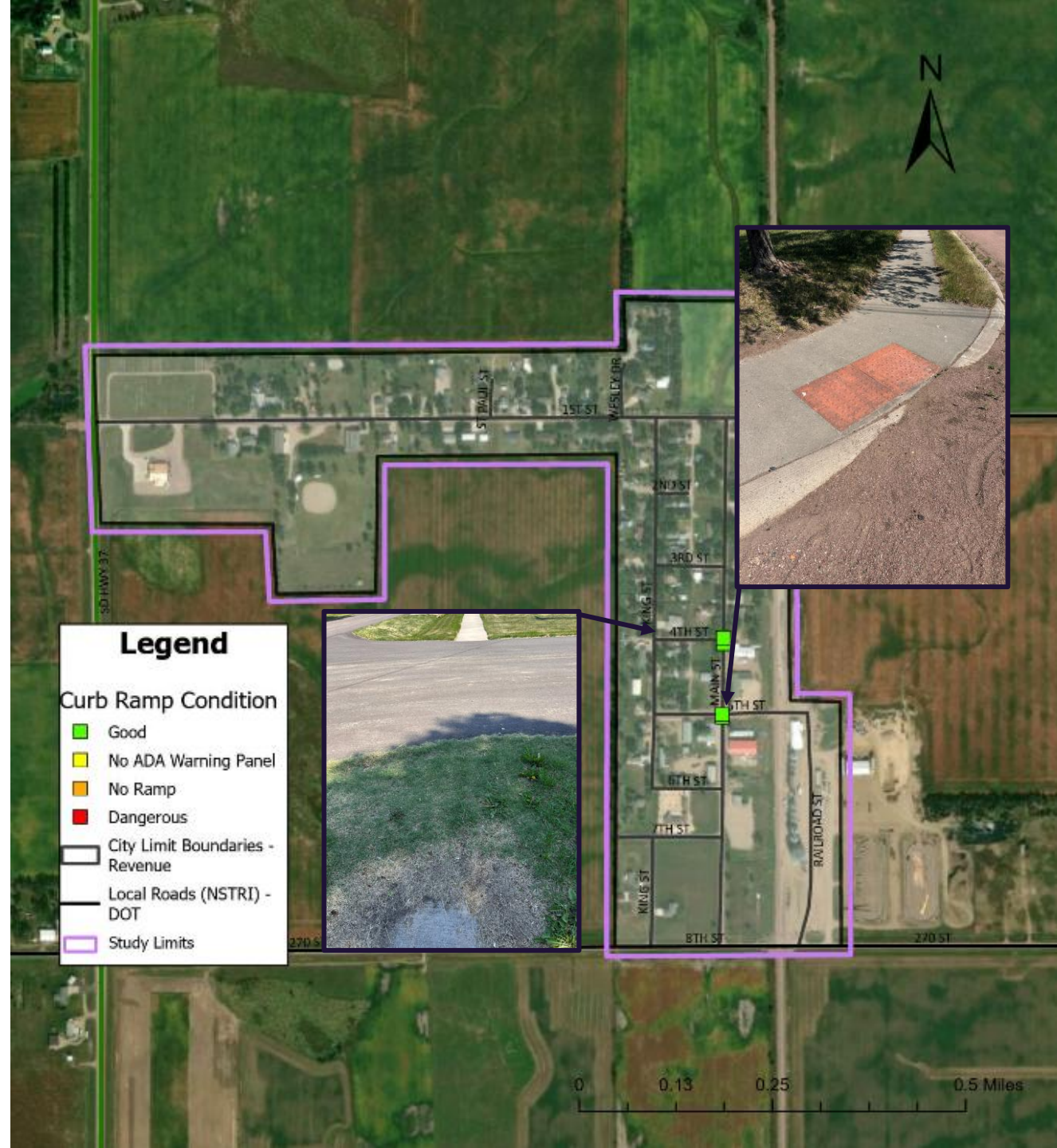


# Curb Ramp Condition Map

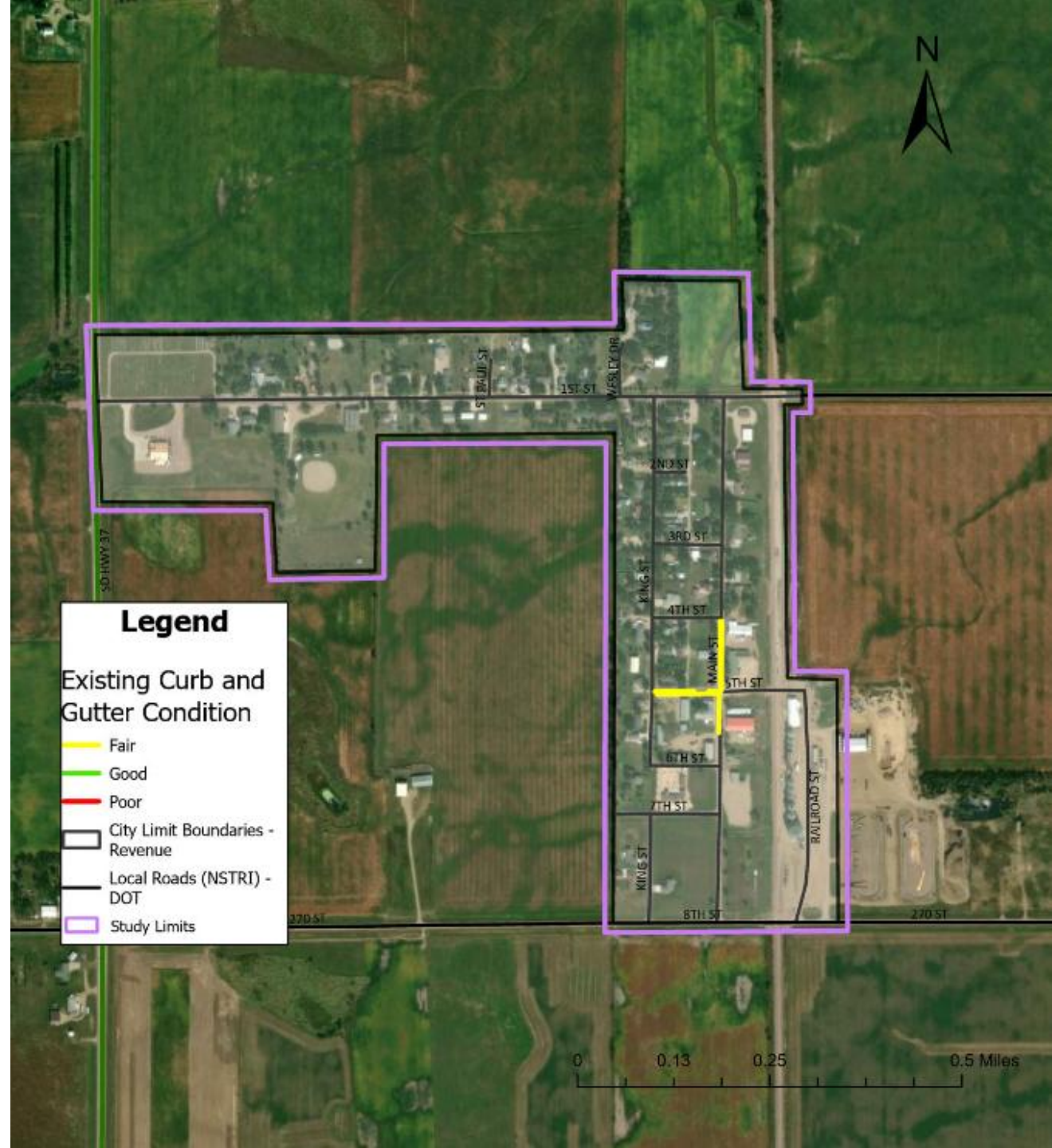




# Curb Ramp Condition Map

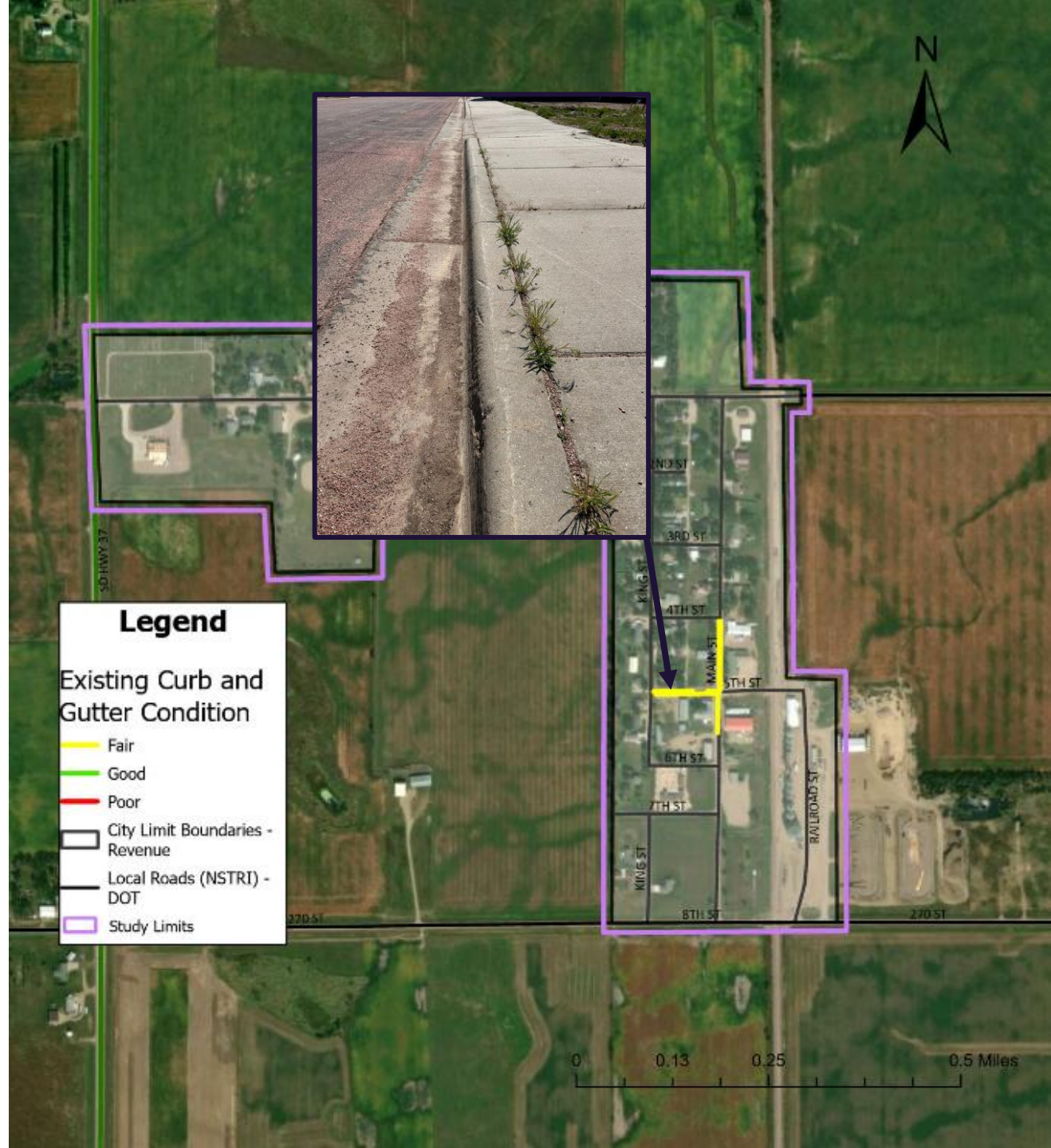


# Curb and Gutter Condition Map



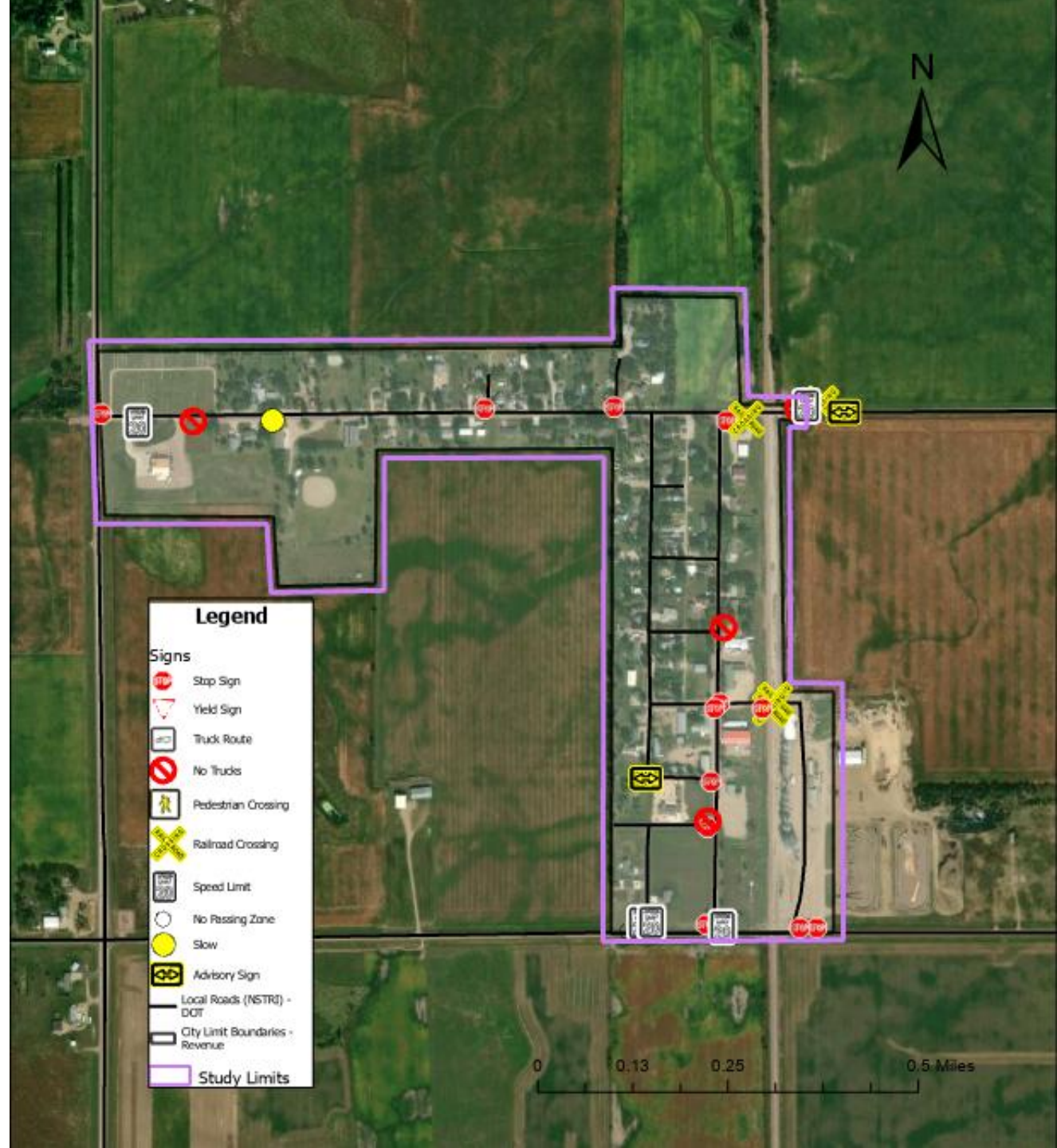

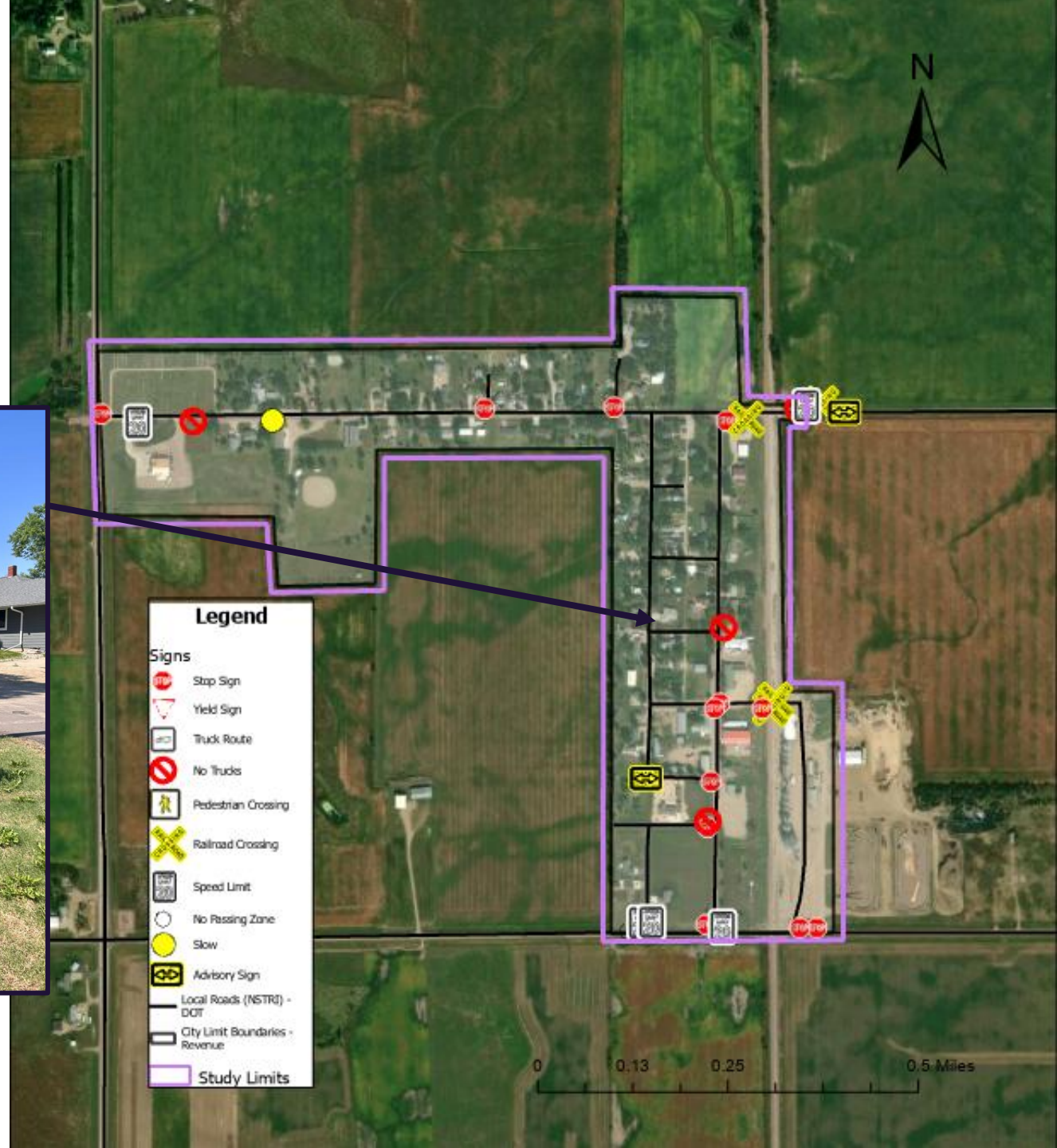
