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Aircraft Registration

SDCL 50-11-9 and 50-11-11 requires that all aircraft based and operated in South Dakota be registered annually with the Department of Transportation. The deadline for annual registration is March 31 each year. The following chart shows the calculated annual fee based on the age and weight of your aircraft.

Owners or lessees of new or used aircraft not previously registered in this state must, within 30 days of operation, register such aircraft with the South Dakota Department of Transportation. If taxes and penalties are due, annual registration of the aircraft may not be completed without collection of those taxes. Failure to pay the registration tax is a Class 2 misdemeanor. In addition, failure to pay the registration tax within 90 days of the due date shall result in a civil penalty of one-half percent of the tax due for each month, or portion of the month, until the tax is paid, not to exceed five percent of the tax due.

Near the center of the Flight Plan form, select Plan, Optimize, or Evaluate.

Plan – Plan a Route provides multiple route options using the departure and destination for your flight plan. Select from Recent ATC Assigned, GPS Direct, Low Altitude V Airways, VOR Direct, FAA Preferred, and Coded Departure Routes.

Optimize – The Altitude Optimization dialog box displays up to five different altitude options and the corresponding ETE and fuel consumption estimates. The Estimates are based on the aircraft characteristics and the winds aloft.

Evaluate – Summarizes the TAF and adverse condition forecasted to be present along the route of flight based on the proposed departure time, airspeed, and wind for 13 different departure times, in +/- 1 hour increments from the proposed departure time.

OBTAIN A BRIEFING

Enter required flight plan information; select Route Brief at the bottom of the Flight Plan.



When the Briefing Customization dialog is displayed, select Standard, Abbreviated, or Outlook Briefing, then select the options for your briefing.

Standard – Provides the complete set of aeronautical and meteorological data offered by Flight Service for the flight plan.

Outlook – Intended for departure times more than 6 hours from the current time.

Abbreviated – Only includes aeronautical and meteorological elements selected by the pilot.

Select the briefing output format: *Web*, *PDF*, or *Email*.

FILE A FLIGHT PLAN

Enter required flight plan information; select File at the bottom of the Flight Plan. Any incomplete fields or invalid entries on the flight plan form will be highlighted.




REQUEST A NAVLOG

Enter required flight plan information; select Navlog at the bottom of the Flight Plan, then select the items to be included in the NavLog. Any incomplete fields or invalid entries on the flight plan will be highlighted.

SuperAWOS Weather Reporting (For advisory use only)

SDDOT and the Aeronautics Commission have purchased over 18 SuperAWOS™ units installed at airports throughout South Dakota. These units provide valuable weather reporting services at smaller airports that do not qualify or cannot afford to install and maintain traditional AWOS equipment.

SuperAWOS provides altimeter and visibility measurements necessary for instrument operations, as well as other advisory information such as temperature, dew point, humidity, density altitude, ceiling and wind.

SuperAWOS data is available on the airport's Common Traffic Advisory Frequency (CTAF) or other designated frequency, on the web at dev.potomacaviation.com/select.php or by phone at 617-262-3825. When calling, the automated system will ask you to enter the airports 3-letter identifier. You may enter another airport's identifier at any time to get weather from another SuperAWOS.

Information is also available on XM Weather®.

When flying into an airport with SuperAWOS, key your mike for AWOS advisories or lights.



Ground Communication Outlets

GCOs (Ground Communications Outlet) have been installed at 16 airports in South Dakota: Britton, Brookings, Chamberlain, Gregory, Hot Springs, Huron, Lincoln County, Madison, Miller, Mobridge, Platte, Spearfish, Sturgis, Vermillion, Winner and Yankton. Each unit will use 121.725.

A GCO is a non-staffed, remotely controlled ground to ground communications facility. Pilots may contact ATC (Minneapolis or Denver Center) or FSS (Flight Service Station like Huron Radio) via standard VHF aviation frequencies through a telephone connection to obtain an instrument clearance, or to activate or close an VFR or IFR flight plan. You may also get an updated weather briefing prior to takeoff. At an airport with a GCO, pilots will generally use 6 "key clicks" on **121.725** to contact FSS, and 4 "key clicks" to contact an ATC facility. See the table below for airport-specific use.

Because the GCO frequency will be shared throughout the area, the GCO should only be used on the ground. Use in the air will cause interference with other GCOs.

To Use: Change frequency to 121.725. To contact FSS, key your mic 6 times. This will initiate a telephone call to Flight Service. To contact ATC, key your mic 4 times. Once the specialist answers the telephone, identify your aircraft and airport, and state your request. Use standard radio procedures, but note; **YOU MUST KEY YOUR MIC ONCE EVERY MINUTE WHILE THE SPECIALIST IS PAUSING, OR THE CALL WILL DISCONNECT.** When completed, the call will disconnect after one minute. If this process fails, please file a PIREP.

GCOs are to be used only while on the ground.



Flight Service and Air Traffic Control

Flight Service provides pilots with weather and aeronautical information through pilot briefings, flight planning, inflight advisory services, weather cameras, search and rescue initiation, aircraft emergencies, and Notices to Airmen (NOTAMs). Flight Service delivers services through a combination of government personnel and a contract service provider (Leidos), which includes Alaska, CONUS, Puerto Rico and Hawaii.

The Flight Service Pilot Web Portal 1800wxbrief.com allows pilots to receive online preflight briefings, file flight plans and get automatic notifications and alerts, including flight plan closure reminders. Registering for automatic notifications keeps pilots informed when new or adverse conditions arise, such as a severe weather forecast or observation, an airport closure, NOTAM or temporary flight restriction.






FIGURE 8 —Density Altitude Chart.

National Parks and Rapid City Regional Airport

When flying over Mount Rushmore National Monument, stay above 7700' MSL unless cleared by Ellsworth approach. This is a high traffic area, and caution must be used. Expect CTAF 123.3 to be assigned by Ellsworth Approach. National parks and wildlife refuges are also noise-sensitive areas, so remain above 2000' AGL.

When flying in the vicinity of Rapid City Regional, be aware that Ellsworth Air Force Base is 5 miles northwest of the airport, and is easily mistaken for Rapid City Regional.
